## The Planned Asthma Visit



- \_\_\_\_\_ Affirm the diagnosis of asthma/ concept of a chronic disease \_\_\_\_\_ Classify "severity" and "control" (2007 NAEPP Criteria)
  - \_\_\_\_Assess impairment (past 2-4 weeks)
  - \_\_\_\_Assess risk (past 6-12 months)
  - \_\_\_ Spirometry & validated questionnaires
- \_\_\_\_Address "inflammation" vs "bronchoconstriction"
- \_\_\_ Differentiate "controller" vs "rescue medication"
- \_\_\_\_ Identify triggers and provide specific guidance for avoidance
- \_\_\_\_ Jointly develop treatment goals & promote self-management
- \_\_\_\_ Teach spacer device technique; other delivery devices
- \_\_\_\_ Write an Asthma Action Plan and review:
  - \_\_\_\_ daily management & how to recognize early s/s of worsening
  - \_\_\_\_ step-up "Yellow Zone" plan for home management
  - \_\_\_\_ when and where to seek medical attention
- \_\_\_\_ Reassess control in 2-6 weeks, adjust Rx, & modify Action Plan
- **\_\_\_** Complete school forms for the use of Albuterol & spacer for school
  - \_ Administer the annual influenza vaccine, regardless of severity

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
